Smiles mission, a person's perception of environment regarding personal development is a key for growth.

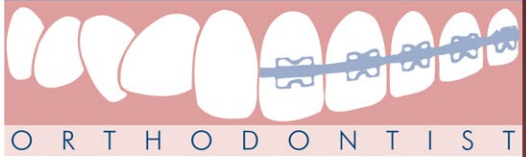

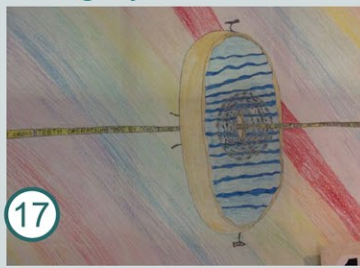
